About the College



Govt. PG College Rajouri is located at a small plateau at village Kheora, two and half kilometers to the north of City of Kings, Rajouri town. College campus gives a picturesque look in the backdrop of snow capped Pir - Pinjal Mountains of the Middle Himalayas in the far north. A monument of Mian Hathu's times Dhani Dhar Fort lies just to the east, in the west lies the Darhal Tawi a source tributary of Manawar Tawi and historic Rajouri town in the south. College has latitude at 33.25°N latitudes and 69.30°E longitude. College has been constructed at a plateau spreading its grandeur of buildings, lawns and grounds over almost 100 kanals of land, which houses three separate hostels for boys and girls and staff quarters apart from administrative block, lecture theatres, well equipped laboratories and a Multi-purpose Hall to carryout extracurricular activities. The College was reaccredited with "A" Grade by NAAC in 2014. The Colleges has the distinction of being funded by the Department of Science and Technology (DST) Govt. of India under FIST Programme-2014. The College feels honoured on being recognised as College with potential for Excellence (CPE) by UGC New Delhi in April 2016.
